Bettie (Trice) Grier was born September 16 1939 in Thomaston Georgia, where she attended school there. She moved to Passaic, NJ 20 years later and became a licensed beautician graduating from Poro beauty School of Newark . Bettie was a faithful member of Mt. Moriah BC and a member of the Senior and Mass choirs. She was a former member of New Faith Church Passaic, and the Fellowship Missionary BC of Thomaston.

Bettie was the V. President of the Passaic Parent Football Club from 1980-1995, and a lifetime member of the Passaic NAACP . She enjoyed acting in Plays and performed in "Glory Train" and "Rapture" 2 Plays written by her cousin Deaconess Dorothy Smith at Union Baptist church .

She was a certified nursing assistant and Home health aide for patient care. She worked at Passaic General Hospital for 18 years, retiring in 2004 and returning to her hometown, family and friends in Georgia, there she rejoined the Fellowship Missionary BC where she was a member and treasurer of the Mass choir , the committed women of Worship and the Culinary Committee. She was a volunteer for the annual Thanksgiving meal affair from 2004-2016, a member of the Red Hatters of Thomaston and active in the Thomaston-Upson County Senior Citizen Center.
