Deonna Lynn Mallory Davis was born on November 8, 1955 to the late Jefferson and Argentina Mallory in Paterson, New Jersey. She was the youngest of three children. She was educated in the Paterson Public School district and graduated from Eastside High School in 1973. She studied Early Childhood Education and Social Work at Passaic Counting Community College, Bloomfield College, Montclair State University, The College of New Jersey and Jersey City University.

Deonna, or Dee as she was affectionately called by her family and friends, had strong Christian values, which were instilled in her by her mother, early on as a priority in her daily walk of life. These values a powerful force impressed upon her and her siblings. At the age of 13 while worshipping at the Neighborhood Baptist Church she accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior. In 1995 she became a disciple of the St. Luke Baptist Church. These principles gave her roots and a foundation that would anchor her as an adult.
