Whether cheering on her nieces, Kimberly and Kelly, and nephew Kevin, or spending quality time with her brother Ricky, whom was her other half, and his wife Freya, Gaby celebrated every milestone and offered her unwavering support. She also adored her dog, Amber, who was not just a pet but a cherished companion and confidant.

Gaby’s kindness knew no bounds. Her friends, neighbors, and even strangers knew her as someone who gave selflessly, always offering her time, love, and a helping hand. Her humor and warmth brought people together, and her big heart left an indelible mark on everyone she met.
